ZO Atkinson read compliance checklist. Project is enclosure of existing second floor deck. No increase in FAR or Lot Coverage. Design review only as project is visible from Denison Avenue. Architect Keegan presented his application. Motion to approve made by Krafjack, seconded by Roberts. Vote in favor unanimous.
