

MINUTES
PUBLIC HEARING ON PROPOSED FY2018-19 BUDGET
BOROUGH HALL
MARCH 19, 2018

Warden Jeffrey Callahan opened the hearing at 6:32 pm, and stated that the hearing was being recorded. In attendance were the Board of Warden & Burgesses, less Burgess Adair, Clerk-Treasurer Tiffany Cook, and six members of the public.

Warden Callahan began by reviewing the projected revenue for the coming fiscal year, totaling \$1,249,048. Revenue includes a slight (1.8%) increase in the mill rate to 2.9 mils from 2.85 mils and a transfer of \$69,390 from accumulated reserves. Budgeted expenses also total \$1,249,048.

Comments from the public supported an increase in the Borough's contribution to the Stonington Ambulance Corps.

Jesse Diggs of School Street encouraged the Board to provide more funds for street repairs, specifically Water Street. Warden Callahan noted that redoing Water Street is a major project, which the Borough cannot afford at present.

The hearing closed at 6:55 pm.
